

Mr Vig is a dual fellowship-trained glaucoma and cataract surgeon and ophthalmologist. After undergraduate studies at Oxford University, he trained as a physician before his ophthalmology training on the North Thames Moorfields rotation. He has fellowships from Moorfields and the Western Eye Hospital. His current NHS practice, based at the Western Eye Hospital, covers complex glaucoma and cataract and he offers the full range of treatment options including laser, trabeculectomy, Preserflo, aqueous shunts and MIGS. For private cataract surgery, he offers a comprehensive range of premium lens options, including monofocal plus, EDOFs and multifocals. Through his work as a consultant in the Western Eye Hospital A&E, he is able to offer a comprehensive emergency and general ophthalmology.

At a national level, he is an elected member of the RCOphth Council and has advised the General Medical Council. Mr Vig has received awards for his extensive education and teaching work. Research interests include outcomes for novel surgical devices and glaucoma laser. He was recently Quality and Safety Lead for Ophthalmology, before taking up a trust-wide review role with the Medical Directors' Office at Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust. He prides himself on his patient-focused approach, communication skills and the rapport he forms.

Referring Patients

We welcome referrals to see patients at the hospitals shown above. Mr Vig is usually able to see emergencies at short notice. For cataract surgery, the self-pay cost varies depending on location, anaesthetic and lens options, with prices starting from around £2600. Istent, Hydrus and laser options are available for patients with glaucoma or OHT. All major insurers are accepted.
